- a) Testimonies about Bob, sent by folks associated with Eigg for his funeral on 15 January 2014.
- b) Bob's minute of the first Isle of Eigg Trust public meeting with residents on Eigg, 25 October 1991.
- c) 3 of his letters to me about the Trust: 10 Dec 1991, 7 July 1992, and undated from the same era.

I have compiled this after being contacted by a student from Germany, Luisa Heine, who is conducting her research thesis, The Transformative Power of Utopias: Investigating the potential of social utopias by looking at the visionary Isle of *Eigg*. The first thing I told her is that none of Scotland's community land trusts will be found to be "utopian"! There are now some 500, covering very nearly 3% of Scotland's 19 million acres, but at the same time they are visionary, and most are a

long way off from being dystopian. With Eigg, the limited vision of the four of us who were the original trustees in 1991 has been massively and wonderfully surpassed by the residents.

For clarity, I describe the Isle of Eigg Trust as "the original". This was set up in 1991 using a traditional charitable trust legal form, without limited liability, by Tom Forsyth, Bob Harris, Liz Lyon and I. Calling it "the original" is to distinguish from its successor, the Isle of Eigg Heritage Trust (IEHT), which was set up in 1997 by the residents after most of the £1.6 million had been raised in 10,000 donations, to purchase the island in 1997 and to run it, democratically accountable unto themselves but in partnership with Highlands Council and the Scottish Wildlife Trust, under charitable and limited liability corporate status in law. One of my happiest moments was when the Secretary, by then of both trusts, Maggie Fyffe, asked me to send the lawyer a letter assenting to the transfer of the original trust's funds and the winding up of the old trust. Since 1994 "the original" had been run by a board elected by the residents (I was asked to stand and was elected by them, for continuity), but by 1997 it had completed its purpose.

The pages in this PDF have been compiled for Luisa's work and others who might be interested in the history. Importantly, they reflect the tensions both within the original Trust, and between the Trust and rightly critical Eigg residents in the early days. Bob was sheep farmer in Lochwinnoch outside of Glasgow, a local community counsellor and a poet. He was pivotal to the venture's credibility. After the buyout, and as Eigg's residents came to build their new community hall, which they had been not allowed to do under the private landlord, Bob made a stained glass phoenix to commemorate the transition. It would have given him great joy that the islanders positioned it in the top window of the hall. In 2023, Camille Dressler (Eigg's resident ethnographer and historian, and an elected director of the IEHT) had the image made into fridge magnets to raise funds for medical relief in the Ukraine war. That's the image placed above. Enjoy these papers as both history and as testimony to the visionary, practical, loving spirit of the great Bob Harris. Alastair McIntosh, 6 Feb 2024

A sharing about Bob Harris, a founding trustee of the original Isle of Eigg Trust, at Bob's funeral

Me: Bob always said that what he did on Eigg was the most important thing he'd ever done in his life. When Tom Forsyth first asked me to become involved I gave it a 1% chance of success. After I'd met Bob, that rose to 5%.

Tom Forsyth: Bob gave the early Isle of Eigg Trust credibility with crofters like Angus Mackinnon, because they saw the rest of us as very dubious.

Simon Fraser: I remember the day we finalised the deal to buy Eigg. I had travelled to Edinburgh for the purpose. That night I stayed with Bob and Shiela and Seumas. It was a great night and Bob was on cloud nine. He was very highly thought of in Eigg. His quiet practical common sense and his own farming background did a lot for the credibility of the cause.

Maggie Fyfe: Sad to hear about Bob also - he was a lovely man & we all have fond memories of him. Delighted we have 2 of his stained glass panels as a permanent reminder.

Camille Dressler: I will always remember the lovely time we all had with Bob and Tom together for one of our anniversaries and his beautiful symbol of the phoenix rising in the hall will always be there to remind us of his important role in our determining our future.

Me: That phoenix is positioned in the window at the head of Eigg's community hall. A couple of years ago we danced beneath it with 14 planners from the Indonesian province of Papua who had come to Eigg to study community development. The phoenix has spread its wings across the world, in so many ways, and I leave the last word with something that Tom said to me as we came in this morning.

Tom Forsyth: William Blake said that normally we see life only through a wee chink. But when the doors of perception are open, we see everything as it is – infinite. Bob saw with 360 degree spiritual vision.

Dear alastain,

Coming home from our last meeting I had a lot of second thoughts on our approach to acquiring ligg and I decided to postpone my visit to the estand until I had clarified a few things in my own mind and got an arswer from each of you on the following questions:

Has each of you considered that we are carrying the responsibility for the future lives of about to people and that this responsibility is a serious business and not a game?

I have been delegated to face the islanders or land use but I have no doubt I will be asked to assure a lot of searching questions or our intended plans. Karlow Helliwell says she has not got many hard facts to go or but no more have I. This is a hot seat I feel ill prepared to occupy. These people are clearly not stupid and they will know a load of waffle when they hear it.

It is particularly in our approach to funding that I am perpleted. It is all very well for dis to murmer all will be well "because she thinks it will be well (which she does!). I have not yet got proof of her sainthood - as yet amyway!

It is all very well for you to cook up scheme

It is all very well for you to cook up schemes to get the island for nothing, with a revolutioning government occupying the Loodge or whatever treatistic" affects included, or the highly unlikely happening of Keeth or Maggie gifting the island or doing a finale deal at a low pice. They have both spet a fortune fattening the legal profession and they will be wanting to get the last bambel out of the place. It at the most likely happening in the real would.

It is all very well Ion saying he is spreading the word as he travels the land (as he does) but where is the money?

I do not like this feeling of being dishonest. I think the time has come for us to buckle down of find enough money to give Jon the apportunity to find raise seriously. It's no good him living like a nomad and bumming around the country, however well adapted he is to this existence. Ohe needs some security

to de the job and a base where he can work from and he sure he has enough to pay the groces. Ale will also, no doubt, need to travel around at times and meet people, so he should have the price of a Band B is his pocket. Can we not, between us, find mough sponsors to k assure him of an absolute minimum of say, to be week, for 6 months at least? Hot's to 1,820 is total. Are thre 9 people who would give \$200, or 18 who would give \$100 to get this off the ground? I am prepared to put \$200 into this of Juil see what I can do to raise further money from other sources. This may manage a bit too. Cect of 3,000 people it's a job to muster a quorum of 8 here for a meeting to be conducted at all. Sad! Because the people who live elsewhere do not know best. The consultants do not know best, not the officials who live is distant places and if they risit you at all, do so in a motor car. Listen to them by all means, but make your own decisions in the light of your own knowledge and understanding.
